Two in the competition track, one clinicing. Aengus Repeta placed 9<sup>th</sup> overall and Gavin Levin placed 28<sup>th</sup>.</li> <li>• This season we implemented the 1Risk accident reporting system. It took some work to get it configured for our needs but by the end of the season it was working OK and Patrollers were getting comfortable with it. Not as fast as the paper form but you can read it and print out a quick report to give to the ambulance crew when needed. All documents for accident investigations are attached to the initial report so they don't get lost. Next season we plan to add other departments reports to it.</li> </ul>
